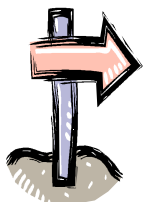

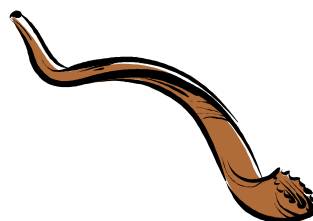

## Obituary: Sister Geraldine Lucas

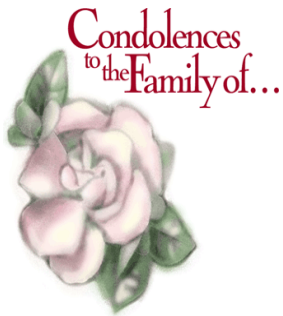

# Caregivers' r e m e m o r y

## *You Are Not Alone*

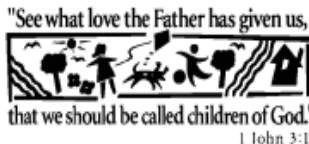

As caregivers, we often decline invitations to attend events. It is difficult to take a bedridden person to a picnic in a park. It's tough to maneuver a wheelchair into a dinner theater. It's awkward to eat in a restaurant when one's guest makes strange noises, drools, must be fed, or eats with their fingers. And it is even more difficult to maneuver a wheelchair on an airplane. People we know sometimes stop inviting us places. Maybe they are practicing compassion--they don't want to flaunt their active lives, so to avoid awkward situations, they stop inviting. Or, they do not want to watch you struggle with a wheelchair or locating a restroom in a public place.

Caregiving can be lonely. It seems like the world is divided into those who go out and those, like us, who stay at home, oftentimes unvisited. But we are not alone. God understands how we feel when we see events in full swing--and we haven't been invited, or cannot go because of the condition of those we take care of.

The Bible records stories of people who endured great loneliness. The book of Genesis tells of Abraham's concubine, Hagar, who knew what it felt like to be barred from events. She knew what it felt like to sit alone and watch her suffering son. She sobbed. The God who understood heard her, joined her, and met her needs. Mephibosheth must have known what it felt like to be left out with his crippling ailment. God understood him, joined him, and met his needs. He sees you, too. He joins you. He meets your needs.



*Father, please don't let me forget that I am not alone in my loneliness. You know what it feels like to be left out--and You comfort the lonely. Please let me feel Your presence and comfort today.*

He is such a wicked man that no one can talk to him." Abigail acted quickly. She took two hundred loaves of bread, two skins of wine, five dressed sheep, five seahs of roasted grain, a hundred cakes of raisins and two hundred cakes of pressed **figs**, and loaded them on **donkeys**. Then she told her servants, "Go on ahead; I'll follow you." But she did not tell her husband **Nabal**. As she came riding her donkey into a mountain **ravine**, there were David and his men descending toward her, and she met them. David had just said, "It's been useless—all my watching over this fellow's property in the wilderness so that nothing of his was missing. He has paid me back **evil** for good. May God deal with David, be it ever so **severely**, if by morning I leave alive one male of all who belong to him!" When Abigail saw David, she quickly got off her donkey and bowed down before David with her **face** to the ground. She fell at his feet ... "My lord, let the **blame** be on me alone. Please let your servant speak to you... May my lord pay no attention to that wicked man Nabal. His name is **Fool**, and **folly** goes with him... Now since the LORD has kept you, my master, from bloodshed and from avenging yourself with your own hands, as surely as the LORD lives and as you live, may your enemies and all who **intend** to harm my master be like Nabal. And let this gift... be given to the men who follow you. Please forgive your servant's offense, for the LORD will certainly make a lasting dynasty for my master, because he fights the LORD's battles. Let no wrongdoing be found in you as long as you live. Even though someone is pursuing you to take your life, the life of my master will be bound securely in the **bundle** of the **living** by the LORD your God. But the lives of your enemies he will hurl away as from the pocket of a **slings**. When the LORD has **done** for my master every good thing he promised concerning him and has **appointed** him **leader** over Israel, my master will not have on his conscience the **staggering burden** of **needless** bloodshed or of having **avenged** himself. And when the LORD has brought my master success, remember your servant." David said to Abigail, "Praise be to the LORD, the God of Israel, who has **sent** you today to meet me. May you be blessed for your good judgment and for keeping me from bloodshed this day and from avenging myself with my **own** hands. Otherwise, as surely as the LORD, the God of Israel, lives, who has kept me from harming you, if you had not come quickly to **meet** me, not one male belonging to Nabal would have been left **alive** by **daybreak**."
